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For 65 years Open Doors has been answering the call to go to the most persecuted Christians in the world to 'strengthen what remains' (Revelation 3:2). Founded by Brother Andrew in 1955, Open Doors works in over 65 countries, providing support, training, literature, advocacy and prayer to the Body of Christ in the places where being a follower of Jesus can mean discrimination, loss of livelihood, liberty and life.

On a speaking tour in the US in the early 1970s, the founder of Open Doors International, Brother Andrew met with several Christian leaders who later established a national office which was incorporated in 1973. This year marks the 50th anniversary of our US base and a unique moment in history to grow the ministry in the United States upon the foundations of the last 50 years at a time when persecution of Christians is at its highest ever levels.

The persecution of Christians is rapidly increasing and getting worse. Globally, we are the largest

mission supporting persecuted Christians, and our World Watch List research report, as well as being integral to our strategic planning, is a respected, world-leading insight into the persecution of Christians. The past five years have seen our work grow significantly in financial terms and global reach.

Our global strategic outcomes are about strengthening the church to remain as **Salt** and **Light** in their communities; for persecuted Christians to know that they are **Never Alone** in their walk with Christ; achieving **Greater Engagement** in prayer and support from the global Body of Christ; and to see Christians everywhere confidently **Speaking Out** for those who suffer for their faith.

Across our ministry we seek a culture where we: live by our core values daily (see page 5); seek the success of others and work in unity; speak the truth with love; simplify complexity in our work.



Our Statement of Faith

Open Doors is an evangelical Christian ministry. Our Trinitarian faith is enshrined and expressed in the historic creed of the church:



We believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit; born of the Virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate; was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell, the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, from where He will come to judge the living and the dead. We believe in the Holy Spirit; the holy Christian Church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting.



How we Support

Open Doors works in more than 65 countries, supplying Bibles, training church leaders, providing practical support and emergency relief, and supporting Christians who suffer persecution and discrimination for their faith. Our development bases in 25 countries work to raise awareness of global persecution, mobilising prayer, and support and action among Christians. Here's how we support:

- Distributing Bibles and Christian Resources.
 Despite increased security control and restrictions, Open Doors provides contextualised Christian materials in minority languages. Last year, Open Doors distributed more than 1.3 million bibles and books worldwide:
- Training Christians and Church Leaders:
 In the last year, Open Doors trained more than 3.4million persecuted Christians across the world. Trainings include leadership and discipleship courses, trauma care and persecution survival seminars;

- Supporting victims of violence and disaster: In 2021, Open Doors helped 685,887 persecuted Christians with emergency relief, community development, education and medical care. Much of the urgent relief went to persecuted Christians in countries hard-hit by Covid-19;
- Raising awareness and encouraging prayer:
 "Our prayers can go where we cannot." –
 Brother Andrew, founder of Open Doors.
 Across the world, we mobilise prayer support for Christians suffering persecution and discrimination for their faith. We encourage the global church to stand with them in prayer so that they know they are not alone;
- Speaking out in advocacy:
 From the White House to the UK parliament, from the EU to the UN, Open Doors brings the voice of persecuted Christians to the most powerful people in the world.

Development Bases

Open Doors US is one of our 'Development Bases' in our global ministry. Our Development Bases are linked to Open Doors International (ODI - the umbrella organization that oversees our global work) through an affiliation agreement. Our US affiliate has a heritage of half-a-century of engagement with individuals, churches, and foundations, and is an authoritative voice in speaking about the persecution of Christians.

The Development Base's principal purpose is to connect the Body of Christ in their nation to the worldwide church where Christians suffer for their faith in Jesus Christ.

Development Bases engage with individual believers, churches, policy-makers, and media on a national level, primarily to build a community of prayer, through which we believe the Holy Spirit prompts our faithful supporters to give financially and to engage in advocacy for those suffering believers who don't have a voice.

Some of our supporters have been with the ministry for decades, and we are grateful that by God's provision, we have been able to engage many more new supporters.

Our US base is part of a vibrant network of Development Bases, each distinct, but each working in unity with one another, modelling the strength that is found when parts of the Body of Christ work together.

Our other Development bases are found in: Australia, Austria, Brazil, Canada, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Italy, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Philippines, Poland, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom & Ireland.

The successful candidate will have a vision for growth, a strategic mindset, passion for the global church and work as an authentic and servant-hearted leader.

Key accountabilities of the position include:

Leadership

- Develop a strong, positive and enabling relationship with the national Board and Open Doors International (ODI) based on mutual respect, regular communication and support.
